seal publish pronounce and declare the same as and for his last Will and Testament and that  
at the doing thereof he was of a sound and well disposing mind and memory to the best of their  
knowledge and belief

Thomas Spackman of East Bradford in the County of Chester & Province of Pennsylvania  
Y<sup>e</sup> being in health of Body and in my present mind & memory do make Constitute and  
Ordain this my last Will and Testament this Second day of September in the year one Thousand  
Eight Hundred & Six in manner and forme following

First That all my Debts that I owe & my funeral Expence be fully paid by my Executors  
herin after mentioned

Secondly I give and bequeath to my beloved Wife Jane Spackman all and Singular the  
house and place whercon I now dwell with all the household Goods and Stock thereon  
With Eighteen pounds Cash yearly during hir Naturall Life the household goods and Stock at hir  
Disposhel, and after hir Death I give the place unto my son George with his paying fifty  
pounds to be aded unto the three hundred pounds Lying on my Wifes Account, and then  
To be Equely Devided amongst my Children as will hereafter be Specified,

I give unto Friends of Bradford meeting five pounds as a small Acknowledgment of the privilege  
of their burying ground if they Will Except it

And now I shall Show wherem these Debts and Cash Depends, I have sold unto my son  
Isaac all my mill house and place thereunto belongin for one Thousand pounds one  
hundred thereof I give him at my Death in Lye of a Trade and the therofhion remaining  
Between the three hundred pounds and the Debts I owe to Equally Devided betwen all my  
Children Excepting George as Confidred before in three Years after my Decease

And the three hundred and fifty pounds Remaining at my Wifes Death to be Divided  
in the Same Manner in One Years time after hir Decease

I Constitute and appoint my sons Isaac and Daniel Spackman to Execute this my Last will and  
Testament In Witness wherof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal Thomas Spackman -
