Comments:	In 1850, Pleasant had a household of 3 and a real wealth of \$100.2. In 1860, he had a household of 13, a real wealth of \$1000, and a personal wealth of \$1600. Comments: #21. Pleasant was a member of the Nauvoo 3rd Ward. Comments: #31. Pleasant was Bishop of the Harrisville Ward, North Weber Stake from 1877 to 1895. He came to Utah in 1850 and filled a mission to Kentucky from 1869 to 1870. Comments: #41. Moved to Monroe County, Missouri, 1830. Says father first person to join LDS Church in Missouri, 1832. Settled on Fishing River, Ray County, 1833. Had to go to Clay County because of persecution, 1834. Moved into Far West, 1838. Persecutions. Expulsion from Missouri, 1839. Father died, 1839. Settled at Nauvoo. Sister healed by Joseph Smith's handkerchief. Rented Winslow Farr farm on shares. Martyrdom of the Smiths, 1844. Transfiguration of Brigham Young. Member of posse to arrest murderers of the Smiths. Received temple ordinances, 1846. To Iowa, 1846. Enlisted in Mormon Battalion but did not go because of illness. Settled on Pigeon Creek. Worked several seasons in Missouri. To Utah, 1850.	

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At Kaysville one year. To Weber County, 1851. Settled near Ogden.

Elected constable, 1852.

Indian troubles, 1853-54.

Called on mission to Indians in Idaho. ("We were . . . busy teaching this people our language and learning them how to work.")

Grasshopper depredations, 1856.

Accompanied Brigham Young and other leaders back to mission following trip home, 1856. Abortive attempt to persuade Indian girls to marry missionaries.

Carried mail to Salt Lake City. Reformation in Utah.

Utah War activities in Idaho. Mission abandoned, April 1858.

Move south to Spanish Fork.

Captain of police force and minute men, 1858-1869.

Sent teams to help emigrants, 1857-69.

High councilor, 1860=1872.

Invested \$3000 in stock, 1861. I

n charge of cooperative sheep and cattle companies, 1861-70.

Military action against Morrisites, 1862. ("By order of the High Council I took 12 men and destroyed the first saloon ever in Ogden, it being a public detriment.") Destroyed second saloon, 1869.

Mission to Kentucky, 1871-72., principally to make known "true facts" about Mountain Meadows Massacre.

Counselor to Bishop of Harrisville until 1877.

Typhoid, 1879.

President of organization set up to hold Church properties, 1882.

On the underground, 1886-88.

Trip to Canada.

Decided not to settle there but to go home and give himself up. Three months in penitentiary, 1888-89.
